We also owned and managed an internet-based bookstore, Yesteryear Books Ltd with 35,000 volumes. In 2000 I was appointed as the Business Support Supervisor at Canada's largest thermal electrical generating plant – SaskPower's Boundary Dam Power Station

Dot and I then became owners and managers of Moosomin Home Building Centre Ltd., a "Home Hardware Building Centre" before we finally retired.

I have served as a Member of Strata Condo board at Summerland Pineo Court, and as a Member of Strata Condo Board Summerland Turner St.
