Another duty of mine is to liaise with the Desert Cove office, giving them master copies of all the materials needed for the Welcome Package. After receiving the copies, I collate and arrange them in a folder so Shaunie can use them on her " welcome visits ".

The President's plaque (located in the foyer of the Recreation Centre) has been updated and engraved.
